Science Promoting School Program

Show your schools active involvement with science by applying to be part of the STAQ science promoting school program. As a science promoting school, you will receive:

- A certificate to display at school
- The right to display the related logo in your school promotional materials, such as website, newsletter, and email footer.
- Have your school listed on the STAQ website as a recognised school

To attain any level, at least two criteria for that level must be met, in addition to attainment of the previous levels¹. Alternatively, the levels may be automatically attained for continuous institutional membership of the indicated duration.



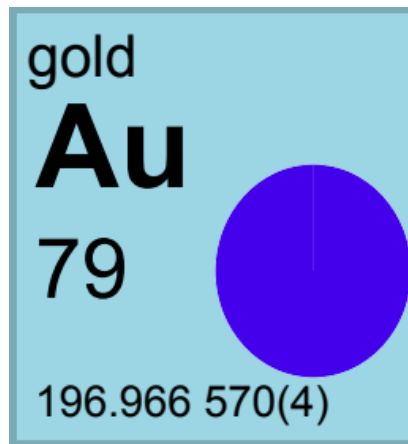
Silver level requirements:

- Your school currently holds STAQ Institutional membership
- Students from your school have submitted entries to the QLD Science Contest

OR

- STAQ Council/ Executive participation

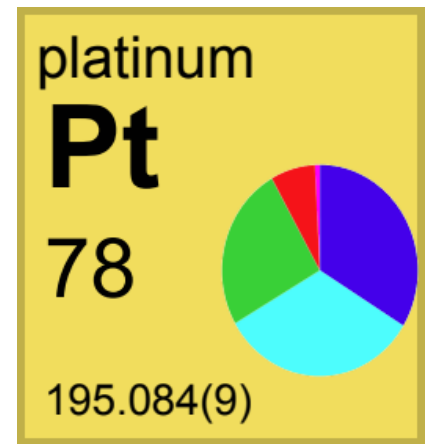
Automatic: 10 years membership



Gold level requirements:

- Silver level attained
- Attendance at a state/national event²
- Participation in Qld Science Contest Judging
- At least one individual member on staff

Automatic: 20 years membership



Platinum level requirements:

- Gold level attained
- Presentation at a STAQ or ASTA State/National event²
- Have a submission printed in the Queensland Science Teacher or Teaching Science³
- STAQ Council/ Executive participation

Automatic: 30 years membership
